This year Valedictorian Shibangi Saha and Salutatorian Shania Chua represented the Class of 2016 on June 4th at Colden Auditorium at Queens College during graduation exercises.

When asked about their inspirations and motivations throughout high school, the duo both attributed their successes to family.

Saha, an only child, felt that, "...my parents dreamt and expected so much of me, which helped me perform so well." She only hopes that she "has made them proud." Chua felt the same, but also credited her brothers. "They were huge inspirations because they were also at the top of their classes, so I really wanted to be as successful as they were." She also attributes much of her success to her math teachers. "I've always gotten along well with my teachers and have excelled in math, which has helped me form strong bonds with them," Chua felt.

Assistant Principal Ms. MaryAnn Safrey informed both Shibangi and Shania in May. Both were surprised when they realized the position they held in the rankings of the Class of 2016. Although Chua knew she ranked among the top students, "The grades between each spot were very close, which made me unsure if I would be Salutatorian." Saha felt the same because, "...rankings were never really known." As another pair of girls to be Valedictorian and Salutatorian, both Chua and Saha were humbled to receive such an incredible honor.

Classmates of Saha and Chua were equally as excited as Shibangi and Shania were.

Perry Chresomales, a close friend of Shania Chua, said, "Shania works really hard, but is extremely caring and always watches out for her friends to make sure they are doing well." He continued to say how proud he was of her and that Shania has been so successful because she is comfortable with who she is.

Laksumi Sivanandan felt that, "Shibangi is extremely compassionate, thoughtful, and intelligent. She really does deserve to be Valedictorian."

Both Saha and Chua are considering studying prehealth/medicine.

Shania, who was accepted to Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Northeastern and Boston College, will attend Villanova where she hopes to study biology and eventually become a Physician's Assistant. Chua chose Villanova because when she got on campus, "It was very welcoming and felt like Molloy, but it also didn't hurt that they had just won the NCAA Championship. Go Wildcats!"

Shibangi will attend Northeastern with hopes to one day attend medical school and study neuroscience.

Similarly to other years, Adelphi University and St John's University will have high numbers from the Class of 2016 in attendance. Come this fall, there are Stanners who will be attending schools such as The University of Notre Dame, Cornell University, and Yale

Varsity soccer player Jesse Rodrigues and Varsity Golf "A" and Varsity swimmer Rebecca Markunas both were named most outstanding senior athlete and received the Jack Curran Award at the annual Athletic Awards Night on Wednesday, May 25th.

A three year Varsity player and team captain as a senior, Rodrigues was an All-CHSAA as a junior and senior. As a senior, Rodrigues was First Team All Tablet, Times Ledger, and All-MSG Varsity First team. He was also MSG Varsity Player of the Year for this season. In addition, Rodrigues was the leading goal scorer for the 2015-16 City Championship Soccer team including scoring the winning goal with 12 seconds left in overtime to secure the championship. Rodrigues will be playing soccer for Siena College in the fall.

Markunas has competed on the golf team for four years and was the captain of the team her senior year. She holds two school records. Markunas was the only girl to compete for the past four years against only boys. She finished

5th in NYS and will compete in the PGA Nationals in July. She is ranked #1 in the Met PGA Junior Player of the Year standings. In addition, Markunas was the Captain of the Girls Varsity Swim team where she holds another two school records.


