

Synopsis and Setting

Set in the 1920s in Orange, NJ, "Radium Girls" follows the lives of several girls employed by the U.S. Radium Corporation. Their tasks: paint watch dials using radium-based paint and meet quota. With dedicated working girls and new management, the company finds more success than could be imagined. But when disturbing medical complications arise, the girls take matters into their own hands and pursue legal action. "Radium Girls" powerfully prompts the audience to take a closer look at the pursuit of wealth, the capitalization of health, laborers' rights, and the fierce determination of the underdog. This gripping drama is inspired by true events.

There will be one 15-minute intermission in between acts.


